EHCP -
Higher Need Funding- up to band 4- depending on individual needs.
SEMH, C+L, C+I, P+D
Pupils do not need to have an EHCP
Can cope in small group- no more than 6.

Includes

Qualified, experienced SEND specialist teachers overseeing all planning, teaching and delivery.

TA/ Sports Coach Support

4 week on entry assessment programme/ nurture support.

Bespoke education and nurture support package planned by specialist qualified teachers

Group interventions e.g. Zones of Regulation, Cool Kids, Forest Schools, Communication and Interaction focus target groups as part of the daily curriculum

Ongoing rigorous assessment package- can align with existing school systems or bespoke to suit need. Reports for EHCP reviews or EHCP application.

Daily Cost

£300

Higher Needs Funding- Band 5 or 6 SEMH, C+L, C+I, P+D (with or without existing EHCP)

Can only cope in small groups for some part of school day.

COMPLEX SPECIALIST SUPPORT PACKAGE

Suitable For

Students at risk or have been permanently excluded due to complex SEN or SEMH,
Students who are not attending school or have poor attendance,

Higher Needs Funding- Band 7 SEMH, C+L, C+I, P+D
Students who cannot cope without 1:1 support for any part of school day.

Includes

As Higher Needs Support Package:
1:1 specialist teaching for all areas of EHCP.

Highly qualified specialist support for all adaptations, intervention and teaching.

Weekly visit from independent SALT for input and targets - sessions developed and led by trained SEN teacher

Weekly visit from OT for input and targets - sessions developed and led by trained SEN teacher

Daily Cost

£500

All placements would involve an initial meeting, observation of pupil, transition visit to The Provision and a bespoke package written in consultation with all relevant professionals, pupil and family.
